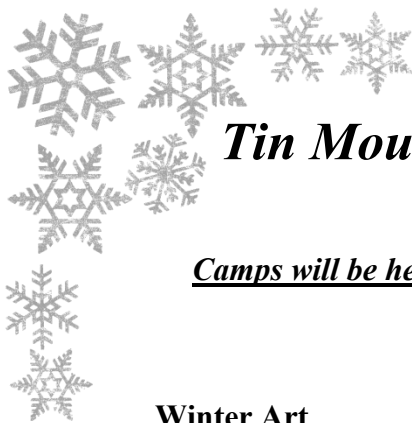




Tin Mountain Conservation Center Winter Camps 2026
